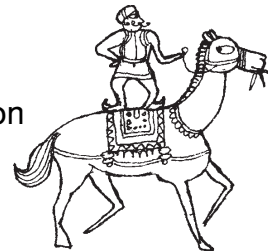


SUPPLEMENTARY READERS – Just Stories for Primary School

PAVO AND CAVO (Picture books)

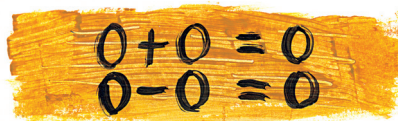
A retelling of the tale of the blue jackal in a style that's tongue-in-cheek is a brilliant demonstration of how to reinvent an old story.
