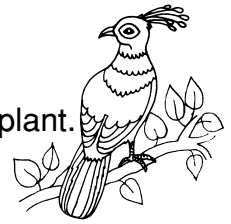


SUPPLEMENTARY READERS — Nature, the Environment, Science
