WHERE I LIVE (series)

A study of children in different living and work environments uses photographs and imaginative text to explore the history, geography, the living traditions and lifestyles of a community or people.

GANDHI BOOKS (series)

Little-known perspectives of Gandhi discovered through different kinds of books – a photo-biography heads off the beaten track to tell his story, a scrapbook – a visual keepsake – captures some of his quirky aspects, and a read and colour book follows his journey towards rocking an empire.

Set against the background of the partition of India and Pakistan, this real story of friendship becomes a means to look at shared histories, memories and crafts. The pictorial narrative that uses the art of women's appliqué work provides a textured visual experience.
